

Epidemiology Internship Information and Criteria

The Epidemiology Program of Florida Department of Health in Orange County offers a unique public health experience for volunteers, interns, or students looking to complete a course practicum. The program, known as the Epi Practice Institute, provides the opportunity to learn about and participate in activities such as public health surveillance, case investigations, clinical services, case management, contact tracing, community outreach, and outbreak response.

The program requires a commitment of 300 hours over the course of 6 months to a year and may involve several tangible products or projects depending on the participant's overall skill, abilities, and knowledge. Due to the level of commitment we make to each program participant, we only allow 1-2 participants per session.
