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## Items Needed for an Immunization Visit

1. Records of previous immunization.
2. Fill out registration form (you can find this in our website under “registration for”)
3. Please bring the child to the visit, sometimes parents/guardians do not bring the child because they think their child do not need vaccines, and many times the does need some vaccines.
4. Clients 17 years of age and younger must be accompanied by one of the following adults:
  - Parents
  - Grandparents
  - Step - parent
  - Uncle
  - Aunt
  - Sister
  - Brother
  - Non – related adults accompanying clients 17 years of age and younger must present an original notarized letter signed by the parent or legal guardian.
5. All clients that are looking for immunization services for first time must present the following forms of identification:
  - Birth Certificate
  - Non expired driver license
  - State ID
  - Passport
  - Military IDPlease note Identification cannot be expired
6. Any kind of government ID is required for:
  - Clients who are 18 yrs. of age and older.
  - Adults accompanying client that are 17 yrs. of age or younger.
