Items Needed for an Immunization Visit

- 1. Records of previous immunization.
- 2. Fill out registration form (you can find this in our website under "registration for"
- 3. Please bring the child to the visit, sometimes parents/guardians do not bring the child because they think their child do not need vaccines, and many times the does need some vaccines.
- 4. Clients 17 years of age and younger must be accompanied by one of the following adults:
 - Parents
 - Grandparents
 - Step parent
 - Uncle
 - Aunt
 - Sister
 - Brother
 - Non related adults accompanying clients 17 years of age and younger must present an original notarized letter signed by the parent or legal guardian.
 - 5. All clients that are looking for immunization services for first time must present the following forms of identification:
 - Birth Certificate
 - Non expired driver license
 - State ID
 - Passport
 - Military ID

Please note Identification cannot be expired

- 6. Any kind of government ID is required for:
 - Clients who are 18 yrs. of age and older.
 - Adults accompanying client that are 17 yrs. of age or younger.
