Items Needed for an Immunization Clinic Visit

- Most recent immunization records
- If vaccinations are needed, please bring the child in to receive immunizations, (many parents/guardians do not bring the child because they believe they do not need vaccinations
- Clients 17 years of age and younger must be accompanied by one of the following adults:
 - Parent,
 - Grandparent
 - Step-parent
 - Uncle
 - Aunt
 - Sister
 - o Brother
 - Legal guardians must present the <u>most recent</u> court ordered paperwork.
 - Non-related adults accompanying clients 17 years of age and younger must present an original notarized letter signed by the parent or legal guardian
- All clients presenting to the immunization clinic for the <u>first time</u> must present one of the following items:
 - Original Birth Certificate
 - o Original Social Security Card
 - Original, non-expired driver's license
 - o Original, non-expired state ID
 - o Original, non-expired passport
 - Original, non-expired military ID
- Valid, government-issued photo identification must be presented at <u>each visit</u> by:
 - Clients who are 18 years of age and older
 - Adults accompanying clients who are 17 years of age and younger
- The following forms of identification are accepted by the Immunization Program:
 - Original, non-expired driver's license
 - Original, non-expired state ID
 - Original, non-expired passport
 - o Original, non-expired military ID
