Treatment date: * CDC Recommended Regimen Uncomplicated gonococcal infections of the cervix, urethra, rectum, pharynx, and pregnant patients: ☐ Ceftriaxone 250 mg IM plus AZ 1 gm preferred * or ☐ Ceftriaxone 250 mg IM plus Doxy 100 mg BID x 7 days (Not for pregnant patients) ONLY IF The individual has a severe cephalosporin allergy: ☐ AZ 2 gm in a single oral dose AND TOC in 1 week	* Infants up to 60 days old with disseminated infection with involvement of liver, encephalitis and infections limited to skin, eyes and mouth; anogenital in children < 12 yrs. Old. ** HPV associated with laryngeal papillomas or recurrent respiratory papillomatosis in children < 6 yrs old; anogenital in children < 12 yrs old.
